This washable, moisture resistant finish is designed for the exteriors of these surfaces. Do not use on surfaces exposed to temperatures over 200°F (93°C) such as stove tops. Not for use in sinks, tubs or other water immersed surfaces.

## PRODUCT APPLICATION

#### **PAINTING CONDITIONS**

Use when air and surface temperature is between 50-90°F (10-32°C) and humidity is below 85% to ensure proper drying. Do not apply to surfaces, when heated, exceed 200°F (93°C).

#### **SURFACE PREPARATION**

Remove all dirt, grease, oil, salt and chemical contaminants by washing the surface with soap and water. Rinse with fresh water and allow to thoroughly dry. Remove loose paint and rust with a wire brush or sandpaper. Lightly sand glossy surfaces.

## PRODUCT APPLICATION (CONT.)

#### **SURFACE PRPERATION (cont.)**

#### **APPLICATION**

Shake bottle to mix product. Unscrew the cap brush and apply Appliance Touch-Up Epoxy using even strokes. For deep scratches or chips, apply multiple layers allowing 10 minutes between coats. For best results, allow to dry overnight before use. **Do not use near open flame.** 

#### **DRY and RECOAT TIMES**

Based on 70°F (21°C) and 50% relative humidity. Allow more time at cooler temperatures. Dries to the touch in 10 minutes, to handle in 30 minutes and is fully dry in 24 hours. Allow to dry 10 minutes between coats.

#### **CLEAN-UP**

Clean up any excess product with lacquer thinner, rubbing alcohol or acetone.
